In order to provide you with reliable and safe power we perform right-of-way maintenance on our power line easements on a periodic basis.

Before a storm ever hits, Laurens Electric Cooperative is planning how to prevent and correct resulting outages. The cooperative has incorporated that proactive attitude into its storm preparation plan through the year-round process of maintaining rights-of-way.

Crews constantly inspect the substations and thousands of miles of lines that serve Laurens Electric's customers. Constant right of way maintenance plays a major role in the overall storm preparation plan.

This process could involve cutting and clearing undergrowth and trimming all vegetation that could cause an eventual power outage or interruption. During this process, we will also ensure that we have adequate access to our infrastructure so that repairs can be made if needed.
