## **QUALIFICATIONS**

- → Applicant must be a high school **junior** at time of application **for Washington Youth Tour**.
- → Applicant must be a high school **sophomore** at time of application **for Cooperative Youth Summit**.
- → Applicant's parents or grandparents may <u>not</u> be employed by or be trustees of Laurens Electric Cooperative. However, students whose parents or grandparents are employees or trustees of the cooperative are eligible to participate in a separate competition. ## **REQUIREMENTS**

- → An application must be submitted.
- → Applicants do not have to live in a home that receives power from Laurens Electric Cooperative but must live/attend school in one of the 7 counties the co-op serves (Laurens, Greenville, Spartanburg, Anderson, Abbeville, Newberry, and Union).
- → Applications should be completed and returned by 5 p.m. on February 2 to Laurier@LaurensElectric.com, or mailed to Laurie Riser, Laurens Electric Cooperative, Inc., P.O. Box 700, Laurens, SC 29360. Applications can be filled out online at www.LaurensElectric.com/youth.

### **JUDGING**

- → Candidates will be judged on the basis of their school and community involvement, references and communications skills. If chosen for an interview, a panel of judges will question the applicants concerning their past experiences, plans for the future and knowledge of the Cooperative.
- → Six winners and one alternate will be selected to represent Laurens Electric Cooperative on the Washington Youth Tour. Three winners and one alternate will be selected for Cooperative Youth Summit. Alternates will attend if one of the winners is unable to participate.

→ Applications are due no later than 5 p.m. on February 2. Any applications or references received later than February 2 will not be considered.
